

## **District Agreement on Fan Behavior**

### **Sportsmanship and Respect:**

- 1.1. All individuals attending district contests must conduct themselves with good sportsmanship and respect for others, including athletes, coaches, officials, and fellow spectators.
- 1.2. Spectators should refrain from engaging in any behavior that may be disrespectful, derogatory, or abusive, including the use of offensive language, gestures, or personal attacks.

### **Positive Fan Behavior:**

- 2.1. Spectators are encouraged to demonstrate positive support for their respective teams and athletes in a manner that uplifts and encourages fair play.
- 2.2. Cheer and show enthusiasm within the boundaries of good sportsmanship and respect for all participants.
- 2.3 Fans are encouraged to cheer for their team.
- 2.4 A fan, student or parent, should never address any athlete or official by name, number or any physical attribute.

### **Safety and Security:**

- 3.1. Spectators must comply with all facility rules and regulations, including any specific guidelines provided by the hosting venue or administrator.
- 3.2. Spectators should maintain appropriate distances from playing areas and respect the boundaries set by officials and event staff.
- 3.3. Report any safety concerns or suspicious activities to the appropriate authorities or event administrators.

### **Compliance with Officials' and Administrator Decisions:**

- 4.1. Spectators must respect and comply with the decisions made by game officials.
- 4.2. Refrain from questioning, arguing, or harassing officials during contests.
- 4.3. Disputes or concerns regarding officiating should be directed to the appropriate district personnel or through established channels after the contest.

### **Prohibited Behavior:**

- 5.1. The following behaviors are strictly prohibited at all district contests include but are not limited to:
  - a) Verbal or physical harassment or intimidation of athletes, coaches, officials, or other spectators.
  - b) Throwing objects onto the playing area or within the facility.
  - c) Possession, consumption, or distribution of illegal substances or alcohol.

d) Any behavior that disrupts the contest or poses a threat to the safety of individuals.

**Consequences of Violations:**

6.1. Individuals found in violation of this policy may face appropriate consequences, which may include but are not limited to:

- a) Verbal warning or reprimand.
- b) Removal from the contest or premises.
- c) Temporary or permanent ban from attending future district contests.
- d) Legal consequences, if applicable, as determined by local laws.
